WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment to the Fiscal Agent Agreement provides that such extension shall be at no additional cost to the parties unless further mutually agreed in writing due to unforeseen circumstances requiring additional time for completion of audit or fiscal closeout activities; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Supervisors finds that approval of the First Amendment is in the best interests of Clinton County and necessary to ensure an orderly and complete fiscal transition and closeout process.
