Clinton County Seeks Applicants for County Judicial Magistrate Appointing Commission

CLINTON – The Clinton County Board of Supervisors is seeking to fill a vacancy on its County Judicial Magistrate Appointing Commission.

The term for the vacancy would begin upon appointment and expires Dec. 31, 2020.

The Board of Supervisors expects to make the appointment during its Jan. 28, 2019, meeting. Applications are due Jan. 25, 2019.
