RESOLUTION TO COMMIT CERTAIN SURPLUS FUNDS
IN THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND BALANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022

WHEREAS, the Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) has issued its Statement No. 54, Fund Balance Reporting and Government Fund Type Definitions, requiring, among other things, all state and local governmental entities to adopt a resolution committing General Fund balance resources for various purposes; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County receives property taxes, state-aid funding and other revenues; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Clinton County Board of Supervisors to adopt this resolution to restrict and commit the fund balance resources of the General Fund and the Rural Service Basic Fund in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and GASB 54; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors that it commits the following funds for Fiscal Year 2022:

 - \$30,000 toward radar equipment
 - \$154,000 toward motor vehicles
 - \$106,870 toward other necessary equipment
- Jail:
 - \$60,000 toward education & training
 - \$197,460 toward miscellaneous supplies and equipment
- Sheriff's Department Investigations:
 - \$6,300 toward G.T.S.B. Expenses
- Sheriff's Department Administration:
 - \$60,965 toward purchase of equipment
 - \$52,000 towards miscellaneous supplies and expenses
- Auditor's Administration Management:
 - \$22,000 toward record digitizing project
- Information Technology-Uniform Patrol Services
 - \$10,185 toward squad car computers
 - \$2,850 toward squad car computer maintenance
