

Sealed bids will be received at the Clinton County Engineer's Office, 1900 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Clinton, Iowa 52732, until 10:00 a.m., April 2, 2025, for a project consisting of furnishing 142 – HP10x42x40ft Steel Piling. The piling is to be delivered to 104 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue DeWitt, Iowa 52742

Bid proposals will be opened at 10:05 a.m. April 2, 2025, and acted upon by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors at 1900 N 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Clinton, Iowa at their next regular scheduled meeting, or at such later time and place as then may be decided. Bid Proposal documents can be obtained at the Clinton County Engineer's Office at the above address. Clinton County will issue a sales tax exemption certificate and letter to the contractor for the purchase of the materials to be used on the project.

Required Delivery Date- June 13, 2025 Liquidated Damages- \$100.00 per day

A certified check made payable to the County, or a Cashier's check, made payable to either the County or the Contractor, drawn upon a state or federally chartered bank or bid bond, shall be filed with each proposal in an amount set forth in the proposal form. Cashier's check, made payable to the contractor, shall contain an unqualified endorsement to the County signed by the contractor or his/her authorized agent. Failure to execute a contract and file an acceptable performance bond and certificate of insurance within 30 days of the date of approval for awarding of the contract, as herein provided will be just and sufficient cause for the denial of the award and the forfeiture of the proposal guarantee.

## INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Prospective bidders must be qualified and have previous work experience on bridge projects as a contractor supplying beams and materials in order to bid on this project.

Proposal shall be submitted using a plain envelope, sealed and plainly marked with "Piling Materials Bid" on the outside with the name and address of the bidder.

Proposal guaranty shall be provided by use of a "Contractor's Bid Bond". In lieu of a bid bond, a certified check, cashier's check or bank draft may be provided as a proposal guaranty. Bidder's proposal guaranty or bid bond shall be attached to the bidder's proposal in a separate envelope.

Unit bid prices must be typed or printed legibly in ink or bid will be rejected, and all bids shall be totaled. Base Bid unit pricing shall be submitted on the bid proposal or proposal may be rejected.

The successful bidder will be required to submit to Clinton County a suitable performance bond of credit in the amount of the Contractor's Bid Amount.

Structural steel piling shall meet the requirements of ASTM A 572 Grade 50 and Iowa DOT General Specification 4167 for Highway and Bridge Construction.

Upon notice of award of the contract the successful bidder shall submit a certificate of insurance coverage in accordance with Iowa Department of Transportation Standard Specification Section 1107.02, to the County. The certificate of insurance naming Clinton County as an additional insured and the suitable Performance Bond shall be submitted to the County prior to execution of the contract.
