I. Call Meeting To Order by Mike Wolf, Chair

The meeting was called to order by Mike Wolf at 3:30pm. A quorum was present. A motion was made to approve the Minutes from the October 25th and November 20th meeting by Tim McClimon and seconded by Phil Tabor.

III. Financial Report

IV. National Association for Court Management conference.

Margaret has requested to attend this school which is next month in Lost Pines, TX on February $8^{th} - 10^{th}$ and will include classes including drug court, mental health and using data to demonstrate. Sheriff Lincoln made a motion to approach the BOS with a



resolution for approval to attend and Phil Tabor seconded that motion. Motion carried.

V. Jail Site Selection

Committee has met every two weeks for past few months and made a great team effort in the evaluation of the many sites. Sites were eliminated if there were less than 3.5-5 acres with the exception of our current jail location. The sites have been narrowed down to four locations, two blueprints, a green area and our current location. These were based on location to hospital and courthouse, zoning, evacuation zones and flood zones (our current location is in a flood zone). Mike Morman of Shive-Hattery came to meetings and answered many questions. An analysis of these four sites from an engineer firm is the next step which costs between \$8-\$10,000. The Jail Sites Committee recommendation is that the funding come from jail room & board rollover fund with permission from the Board of Supervisors. Mike Wolf made a motion to approach the BOS to hire engineering firm to analyze the four remaining sites and seconded by Wanda Wyatt. Motion carried.

VI. CCJCC 2015

Mark Lawson made a motion to approve the 2015 Calendar and Committees and Kim Hess seconded the motion. Motion carried. Sheriff Lincoln made a motion to approve the Strategic Plan and Budget for 2015-16 fiscal year and Mike Wolfe seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Rural Committee will be working together on possible rural citizen candidates.

VIII. Adjournment

A motion was made by Rick Lincoln to adjourn and seconded by Tim McClimon. Meeting ended.
