RESOLUTION 2023-27

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a Board of Supervisors wishes to adopt a “construction evaluation resolution” relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR’s decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the Board of Supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the Board of Supervisors between February 1, 2023, and January 31, 2024, and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the Board’s recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

Resolution 2023-30 discussion: Supervisor George prefers less blanket weed spraying to cut down on adverse effects to pollinators such as bees. She prefers spot spraying only. Chairman Irwin said there is a timing issue with spot spraying. County Engineer Todd Kinney said there is already a time when they are allowed to spot spray. Kinney said this plan has gone on for six years and the reasons they do this plan is because of complaints of weeds encroaching on private property. He said the County could go back to spot spraying. Supervisor Srp said he’s willing to spot spray, but acknowledged the current plan is working well. Srp said broadcast spraying has suppressed some of the noxious weed growth. Srp asked would there be follow up spot spray and Kinney said the County does do that now when reports are given to them.

Motion discussion: Chairman Irwin said there has been an outreach to the County to discuss negotiating a tax abatement on the former Ashford property in Clinton. He said he and County Auditor Eric Van Lancker and County Treasurer Dustin Johnson have been working with the developer to draft an agreement. Irwin said there is a little more than \$1.3 million in tax liability and the agreement would abate taxes at an equal level of what is invested in improving the property. Irwin said if a developer does not take over the property than the County takes the property in a few months and would have to pay for the improvements or demolition. He said demolition could cost around \$5 million. Irwin said the utility bill for the property is also very high per month just to keep the property operational. Andy Sokolovich, Grow Clinton, commended the County for engaging in a development agreement to provide the County a safety net. He did ask the County to encourage the developer to use local resources. Akif Aydin, developer, said he will be in town next week to start meeting with local contractors about the timing of the project.

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to authorize the Chairman to sign an engagement letter with Ahlers and Cooney, P.C. to prepare and advise on a development agreement.

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

Van Lancker reviewed the upcoming meeting schedule with the Board. He said the week features budget presentations on Wednesday and Friday and active shooter training on Thursday.

Johnson reported there is a bill in Des Moines to address the cross-county titling of vehicles.

Supervisor Srp said it sounds like the State may reduce the number of departments across the state and could impact the Department of Corrections locally. He said the local Seventh Judicial employees are not allowed to provide an opinion on the proposal.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Cyber Security Insurance: Julie Bray, local ICAP insurance agent, explained cyber security was originally built into the ICAP policy and then removed as an extra to the policy. She said the premium is now \$28,000 a year for a \$1 million coverage and the County also needs to meet certain cyber-security rules before they can issue the policy. She said the County is working on meeting those requirements. Van Lancker said the County currently has \$20,000 budgeted so a budget amendment may be needed and the amount for the next fiscal year will need to be adjusted up for the continued coverage.

MOTION to approve the cyber security package as presented.

Annual All-Systems Overweight Permit Routes in the County: County Engineer Todd Kinney reviewed the program for Clinton County. The County can identify roads to add to the program up to July 1, 2025. He said permits are \$500 each and issued state-wide. He said the money is pooled and dispersed to counties that have added roads to the list. Kinney thinks the County should add the minimum number of roads to the State to receive some of the state funds. Kinney will create a list of roads that connect to Highways 30 and 136 for consideration. Kinney doesn't believe the Board needs to take action but will review what the next step includes.

10:08 A.M. Hometown Pride Update

Hometown Pride County Coordinator, Francis Boggus, reviewed the annual report he provided to the Board. He said he will ask for the funding to be split 50-50 with the City of Clinton because it is typical to spend half his time in the City of Clinton. He said because of the split he is asking the County for a contribution of \$20,000 for the next fiscal year.
