DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

The Board of Supervisors met with the Clinton County Firefighters Association. The members of the association wanted to talk with the Board of Supervisors about various matters including township funding and communications dispatch services.

The discussion started with townships and fire departments. Chairman Irwin explained how the taxation works for the township. County Auditor Eric Van Lancker encouraged the fire departments to get contracts with their townships. Irwin talked about Communications. He said he and Van Lancker are working on a 28E agreement with first responder agencies, but it hasn't been presented yet. He said the agreement would put into place how many radios an agency will get and how they are replaced. Irwin said the Board levied the dollar amount for the radios and now it is up to Communications and the agencies to coordinate equipment and other matters. Sheriff Bill Greenwalt explained the Communications Commission Board structure. Greenwalt said he believes the technical oversight board could be expanded to communities outside of the three largest cities in the County.

The Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet on Monday, May 20, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the Clinton County Satellite Office at 226 11<sup>th</sup> St., DeWitt, IA.
