RESOLUTION 2024-270 discussion: County EMA Director Chance Kness said he, Medical Examiner Program Director Dr. Margaret Wolf, and EMA Operations Officer Andrew Smith agree the nine ME investigators are needed to be able to fill the schedule. He said they are currently at seven. He said the portion of the budget that would be affected to get to nine is hiring and training. Kness said he has heard from investigators that the lack of on-call pay has been viewed as negative. He said transporters are still getting on-call pay. The Board asked for a presentation on the on-call pay situation when EMA has prepared a report with that information. Chairman Irwin said the call pay was increased to off-set on-call pay. Kness said they are seeing the negative impact of lack of on-call pay in current employees and people interested in working. Wolf said on-call pay may help keep the seven and help fill up the schedule. Irwin said HR is stating they have had more applicants since the new pay plan was implemented. Wolf said the investigators state they are not seeing the same amount of pay. It was generally agreed to continue to post and backfill up to nine.

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

Clinton County Auditor Eric Van Lancker said in-person absentee voting begins Wednesday in the cafeteria of the Administration Building and will continue through November 4. He added the office will be open for voting Saturdays, October 26 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. and November 2 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. He also reminded voters that absentee ballot request forms for ballots to be mailed must be submitted by the end of the day October 21. Van Lancker also reviewed the possible schedule for Board meetings around the election. The bid process for the Law

Center parking lot will begin next week with a resolution to set a public hearing. That schedule would have the project being awarded in mid- to late-November.

Chairman Irwin said he attended the organizational meeting for the Ports of Eastern Iowa and he was named a cochairperson of that committee. He said they also learned of many funding opportunities from various sources. He said they would like to develop the port authority with committees that include elected officials and another that features business leaders and citizens. He said the next wind turbine meeting will be October 30 at the County Satellite Office in DeWitt.

Supervisor George said the fall fest in downtown Clinton during the weekend was well attended and the Sheriff's Office and EMA had good representation.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson thanked HR for getting the position in his office posted quickly and they have received several applications already. He added property tax collection is down to \$1.6 million outstanding for first-half collections. He said past due notices will be sent out toward the end of the month. He said the number of parcels not paid has decreased since his last report.

County Engineer Todd Kinney said the old Highway 61 bridge south of DeWitt is open. He said the overlay on Elvira Road west of Elvira continues and should finish up late next week. He reported the bridge crew is finishing the last bridge of the season and then moving onto two box culverts in a project with the City of Clinton.

County Conservation Director Phil Visser reported the Halloween event at Rock Creek went very well and the campground was full. He said the Blue Heron tours will run until October 24. He said they are starting to winterize the campgrounds this week. He said the Conservation Board meets next week and will open bids for work on the Eden Valley remodel.

County VA Director John Bray said they are going to Des Moines for the annual fall school training. He said the office will be closed and have limited hours the rest of the week.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

County Courthouse Fourth Floor Bat Waste Remediation Estimates: Van Lancker reported maintenance collected two estimates to have the floor cleaned and disinfected. He said one estimate is for \$16,885 and the other is \$11,200. He and Building Maintenance Manager Matt Lancaster reviewed the estimates and the work included and didn't see any major differences between them. Sheriff's Office Chief Deputy Steve Diesch said he has removed three bats since the work was completed, but that is way less than before work was done.

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to engage Get Bats Out for the Courthouse fourth floor bat waste remediation.

County Administration Building Project Update: Van Lancker and Irwin reported window replacement on the first floor of the east side of the building starts today and concrete for the front entry sidewalk is being poured today. Irwin said the Mental Health department and community services offices are moving back in. Johnson said he hopes they will be moving things into their new office area later this week.

10:12 A.M. Public Hearing with Possible Action to Follow

Chairman Irwin called a public hearing to order to solicit public comment on a budget amendment to the fiscal year 2025 Clinton County Budget.

Proof of publication was presented, accepted and returned for filing.

Present were Board of Supervisors, County Auditor Van Lancker, County Budget Director, public and media.

Van Lancker and County Budget Director Nicholas Manrique reviewed the budget amendment.

No comments were received before the hearing.

Manrique said it looks like a large amount of amendments but a lot of it is budgeting ARPA and railpark lawsuit funds. Johnson wanted to make sure the railport lawsuit funds were being set aside for debt service levy reduction. Srp said that is still the plan and should be plenty to meet using 50% of the funds for that purpose. Van Lancker said using those funds for current capital projects will help protect the general fund balance.
