RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SCOTT COUNTY, IOWA,
FOR JUVENILE DETENTION AND DIVERSION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Supervisors recognize both state and federal legal requirements placed on counties which increase the need to use juvenile detention services; and

WHEREAS, based on recommendations from the Clinton County Attorney and Clinton County Sheriff that a juvenile detention agreement with the Scott County Detention Center is needed for Clinton County; specifically for the reduced transport time, for the safety and welfare of detained juveniles and the law enforcement officers, for the ability to provide needed juvenile services that can be continued after the juvenile leaves detention, for the ability for Clinton County families to be involved and part of the juvenile's detention services, education, work, etc.; now

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clinton County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Clinton County Board of Supervisors Chairperson to sign a six-month contract effective July 24, 2025, with Scott County, Iowa, for juvenile detention and diversion services.
