- Section 1. As it states in the third amended Intergovernmental 28E Agreement entered into on December 20, 2022, Cedar, Clinton, Jackson, Muscatine and Scott Counties are member counties within the Eastern Iowa MHDS Region;
- Section 2. Whereas, pursuant to House File 2673, Iowa Code Chapter 225C will be rescinded as of July 1, 2025, and the MHDS Regions will not be responsible for service management activities and/or payment of mental health and disability services provided after June 30, 2025;
- Section 3. Whereas, due to the repeal of Iowa Code Chapter 225C, under section 3.1

 (a) of the December 20, 2022 amended Eastern Iowa MHDS Region's 28E agreement, the statutory requirement for mental health services to be provided through a regional format will terminate the 28E agreement.
- Section 4. This resolution shall take effect December 31, 2025.
