ORDINANCE 2025 – 02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEXT OF THE CLINTON COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE
TO UPDATE THE RE (REUSABLE ENERGY OVERLAY) ZONING DISTRICT.

Section 1: Be it enacted by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors that the text of the Clinton County Zoning Ordinance be amended as follows:

Exhibit “A”

1. Amend Chapter III, section 3.6.10, by updating section 3.6.10.F with the following:

F. Moratorium.
 1. The county shall not approve any request to rezone property to the Renewable Energy Overlay District for a period or periods as described in Sections 3.6.10 while the Board of Supervisors reviews and possibly revises language in this chapter related to utility-scale wind installations.
 2. This subsection 3.6.10.F shall be repealed automatically on:
 - a. September 30, 2025 unless extended before that date by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors until no later than December 31, 2025.

Section 2: The change as hereinabove set forth shall be entered and made part of the Zoning and Ordinance of the County of Clinton, Iowa.

Section 3: If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
