DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Bulk storage of anhydrous ammonia in Preston Iowa: The Board discussed the bulk storage of anhydrous ammonia at the property located at 1009 362nd Ave., Preston, IA. Per the statutes, a discussion at a public meeting is required to move tanks and store anhydrous ammonia. The only utilization is for private use and does not require additional permitting. The Iowa Department of Agriculture inspected the tanks before they were installed. The Board acknowledged that they are aware of the storage tanks and that they have been inspected and approved by the Department of Agriculture.
