RESOLUTION 2025-312

WHEREAS, the Iowa Legislature in 2014 overwhelmingly passed the HBI Act, known as Home Base Iowa, which is a one-of-a-kind program assisting veterans and transitioning service members from active duty military to civilian life; and

WHEREAS, the Home Base Iowa program private-public partnership provides a high-level of commitment and resources for our veterans, transitioning service members and their families; and

WHEREAS, the program offers countless resources to help veterans and their families with education and in transitioning to a new community with focused support and individuals who want to help; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County, Iowa, became a Home Base Iowa Community Partner through formal action on March 8, 2016; and offers an incentive to veterans locating to Clinton County who qualify through formal action on April 11, 2016; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton County Board of Supervisors awards Cody A. Featherston the amount of \$1,500.00 for the qualified reimbursement for a home purchase closing cost; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clinton County Auditor be authorized to pay the claim in the amount of \$1,500.00 to Cody A. Featherston from the General Basic Miscellaneous Fund.

RESOLUTIONS

Resolution 2025-314 discussion: The Board considered a resolution to share the County Engineer with Dubuque County, Clinton County pays salary, FICA, and insurance, then bills Dubuque for its share. Dubuque supervisors expressed gratitude and praised county engineer Todd Kenny; Dubuque is still hiring, with a timeline of 3–12 months. The agreement includes mutual termination language.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of both parties to review the Clinton County Engineer Employment Contract and Agreement annually;

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

Supervisors shared the meetings they will each be attending this week.

Dustin Johnson, County Treasurer, updated property tax collections. After subsequent payments opened last week, tax sale investors paid about \$330,000, reducing the outstanding tax balance to roughly \$800,000.

Todd Kinny, County Engineer, Update on Dubuque County sharing: Their board meets every other Monday, so the engineer plans to attend in Clinton on their off-Monday meetings and split time by livestreaming into the Clinton

County Meeting when possible. He’s been coordinating with Dubuque maintenance/engineering to move plan sets through DOT approval to keep lettings on schedule. He will be in Dubuque County a couple of days a week.

Phil Visser, County Conservation, Conservation Foundation meeting is on December 2nd. The Eco Center will be closed Thursday–Saturday this week for the holiday.

Ally Weller, Human Resources, Anniversaries. In December, Matt Walker (Sheriff’s Office) celebrates five years with Clinton County. Last week’s employee recognition event went well; one employee was missed and will be recognized separately.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Posting of East District Park Supervisor Position for Conservation Board: The East District Park Supervisor (covering Rock Creek, Camp Miss Elk ton, Malone Park, Killdeer, etc.) is leaving, creating a key vacancy. Given the slower season, operations can manage temporarily, but the role is essential in the long term. There’s internal interest in the position, but it will be posted to accommodate veterans' preference, with the best-qualified selected. The board agrees the role is necessary and consents to post the position; the Conservation Board also recommended advancing the hire.

Letter in support of Union Pacific and Norfolk Southern Merger, Docket Number: FD 36873: Discussion on a letter regarding a proposed railroad merger: Members cited ongoing blocked-crossing issues near Camanche and along the Hwy 30 corridor, impacting school buses, first responders, and daily traffic, and urged safety and access mitigation. They favor supporting the merger but want the letter to include these concerns. Although the requested submission date (Friday, Nov 14) was missed, they’ll draft revised language (with Mike’s input), invite public feedback, and bring it back next Monday.

9:30 A.M. Public Hearing with Possible Action to Follow

Chairperson George called the Public Hearing to order at 9:48 a.m. Present were Supervisors Srp, Irwin and George; County Auditor David Troester; and members of the press and public.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to solicit comments proposed text amendment to the Clinton county code of ordinance.
