Resolutions 2026-45 through 2026-46 and five (5) Motions were approved on the consent agenda:

RESOLUTION 2026-45

WHEREAS, the Medical Examiner for Clinton County has determined the need for Clinton County Medical Examiner Transporters; and has found Benjamin Ludemann qualified and appropriate for the position.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that Medical Examiner Transporter services should be provided to the Medical Examiner's Office which is administered by the Clinton County Emergency Management Agency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined Benjamin Ludemann to be qualified and appropriate to be hired and appointed as a Clinton County Medical Examiner Transporter; now

RESOLUTION 2026-47

WHEREAS, Clinton County has previously retained the legal services of attorney Eric Updegraff of Hopkins & Huebner, P.C. in connection with legal matters involving Clinton County, including but not limited to White et al. v. Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa District Court for Clinton County, Case No. CVCV051285; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has been notified by correspondence dated March 6, 2026, that effective March 1, 2026, Eric Updegraff will be departing Hopkins & Huebner, P.C. and joining the law firm of Hinders, Updegraff, and Franklin, P.L.C.; and

WHEREAS, the correspondence advises that the County may elect to continue representation with Mr. Updegraff at his new firm, continue representation with another attorney at Hopkins & Huebner, P.C., or select other counsel; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that it is in the best interests of Clinton County to maintain continuity of legal representation in its pending matters and to continue representation with attorney Eric Updegraff.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors that:

1. Clinton County elects to continue legal representation with attorney Eric Updegraff following his transition to the law firm of Hinders, Updegraff, and Franklin, P.L.C.
2. All legal matters for which Eric Updegraff has been providing representation on behalf of Clinton County, including but not limited to White et al. v. Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Case No. CVCV051285, shall continue to be handled by Mr. Updegraff through Hinders, Updegraff, and Franklin, P.L.C., unless otherwise directed by future action of the Board.
3. The Clinton County Attorney is hereby directed to notify Hopkins & Huebner, P.C. that Clinton County elects to continue representation through Eric Updegraff and requests that the County's files and materials be transferred as necessary to Hinders, Updegraff, and Franklin, P.L.C.
4. County officials and staff are authorized to cooperate with the transfer of files and documentation necessary to ensure continuity of representation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

RESOLUTION 2026-49

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Supervisors sits ex-officio as the Clinton County Board of Canvassers pursuant to Iowa law; and

WHEREAS, the Board conducted the official canvass of the November 4, 2025, City/School Election on November 12, 2025, in accordance with Iowa Code section 50.24; and

WHEREAS, the canvass included the race for School Director District 4 for the Delwood Community School District; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the official canvass, the Clinton County Auditor identified a clerical error in the tallying of write-in votes by poll workers affecting the vote totals reflected in the original abstract for said race; and

WHEREAS, the deadlines for requesting an administrative recount under Iowa Code chapter 50 and for filing an election contest under Iowa Code chapter 57 have expired; and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code does not provide a mechanism for reopening or reconsidering the official canvass after the expiration of such statutory deadlines; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has prepared corrected canvass materials reflecting the accurate tally of votes as returned by the precinct election officials; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary and appropriate to publicly acknowledge the corrected abstract and certify it with their signatures to be the Corrected Abstract of Votes cast in Clinton County for the 2025 School Election on the 4th of November, 2025, for the Delwood School Director District 4 for purposes of maintaining accurate county election records, while recognizing that the official canvass conducted on November 12, 2025, remains the official canvass under Iowa law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors, sitting as the ex-officio County Board of Canvassers, that:

1. The Board acknowledges receipt of the Auditor's Corrected Abstract of Votes for the November 4, 2025, City/School Election for School Director District 4 of the Delwood Community School District.
2. The Corrected Abstract reflects that Lyndsey Eberhart received the highest number of valid write-in votes cast for said office, as shown in the corrected materials prepared by the County Auditor.
3. The Board recognizes that, due to the expiration of statutory recount and contest deadlines, the Board lacks authority under Iowa law to reopen or amend the official canvass conducted on November 12, 2025.
4. Nevertheless, a Corrected Abstract of Votes cast in Clinton County for the 2025 Delwood School Director District 4 Election on the 4th of November, 2025, shall be certified by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors with their signatures for purposes of publicly ensuring accurate and complete county election records, which are maintained in the official election records of Clinton County.
5. Nothing in this Resolution shall be construed as altering the official canvass completed pursuant to Iowa Code section 50.24, but rather as documenting the public process of providing a corrected tabulation for historical and record-keeping purposes.
