Resolution Setting Public Hearing Discussion: The Board considered a resolution establishing a public hearing for the Secondary Roads Department regarding the letting of timber planking materials. The public hearing was scheduled for June 22, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 26.12, it is required that a public hearing be held to approve the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and cost estimate for a public improvement project with an estimated cost greater than the competitive quote threshold; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa that a public hearing for the purpose of approving the plans, specifications, form of contract and cost estimate on said Timber Plank Materials Letting be scheduled for June 22, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Room.

Canvass of the June 2, 2026 Primary Election

County Auditor David Troester presented the official election materials for canvass. The Board reviewed precinct-by-precinct election results, comparing the precinct tally records, voting system reports, and official records to be submitted to the State of Iowa. The purpose of the canvass was to verify vote totals, identify data entry discrepancies, and ensure consistency across all official election records prior to certification. Upon completion of the canvass review, the Board accepted and certified the official results of the June 2, 2026 Primary Election as presented by the County Auditor and directed that the certified results be transmitted to the Iowa Secretary of State in accordance with Iowa law.

The ASVP Board reported the rejection of one provisional ballot due to insufficient voter verification and the receipt of five absentee ballots after the statutory deadline. One eligible Safe at Home absentee ballot received after Election Day was accepted in accordance with state law.

The Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet on Monday, June 15, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.
