Resolutions 2026-142 through 2026-153 and four (4) Motions were approved on the consent agenda:
RESOLUTION 2026-142

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the Auditor to periodically transfer sums from the General Basic and Rural Services funds to the Secondary Road Fund during the 2026/2027 budget year; and
WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with section 331.432, Code of Iowa,

Section 1. The total maximum transfer from the General Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, shall not exceed the sum of \$316,411; and the maximum transfer from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, shall not exceed the sum of \$2,117,710.

Section 2. Within three days of being notified of the apportionment of current property taxes, state replacements against levied property taxes, mobile home taxes or military service tax credit replacements to the General Basic or Rural Services Funds, the Auditor shall order a transfer from said fund to the Secondary Road Fund.

Section 3. The amount of the transfer required by Section 2 shall be equal to the apportionment made under Section 2 to the General Basic or Rural Services Fund, respectively, multiplied by the ratio of said fund's total maximum transfer to the Secondary Road Fund, to the sum of mobile home taxes and total military service tax credit replacements.

Section 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 and 3 of this resolution, total transfers to the Secondary Road Fund shall not exceed the amounts specified in Section 1.

Section 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 and 3 the amount of any transfer shall not exceed available fund balances in the transferring fund.

Section 6. The Auditor is directed to correct his books when said operating transfers are made and to notify the Treasurer and County Engineer of the amounts of said transfers.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, that it authorizes periodic transfer of funds to the Secondary Road Fund for fiscal year 2027.

WHEREAS, the Iowa Legislature in 2014 overwhelmingly passed the HBI Act, known as Home Base Iowa, which is a one-of-a-kind program assisting veterans and transitioning service members from active duty military to civilian life;

WHEREAS, the Home Base Iowa program private-public partnership provides a high-level of commitment and resources for our veterans, transitioning service members, and their families; and

WHEREAS, the program offers countless resources to help veterans and their families with education and in transitioning to a new community with focused support and individuals who want to help; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County, Iowa, became a Home Base Iowa Community Partner through formal action on March 8, 2016, and offers an incentive to veterans locating to Clinton County who qualify through formal action on April 6, 2026; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton County Board of Supervisors awards Ronald Swearingen the amount of \$1,500.00 for the qualified reimbursement for a home purchase closing cost; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clinton County Auditor be authorized to pay the claim in the amount of \$1,500.00 to Ronald Swearingen from the General Basic Miscellaneous Fund.

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

Sheriff Bill Greenwalt recognized three members of the Clinton County Sheriff's Office for their lifesaving actions during a medical emergency that occurred on April 1, 2026.

Chief Deputy Steve Dish, Sergeant Brian Grell, and Deputy Joe Raymakers responded immediately after a restaurant patron suffered a sudden cardiac emergency.

County Auditor David Troester reported that applications for the Elections Coordinator position, recently authorized by the Board, had begun to be received. He also informed the Board that he would be attending Auditor School during the week. The Auditor advised that a resolution would be presented at the following meeting to formally designate the location for posting Board agendas and public notices in compliance with recent changes to Iowa law requiring public access to meeting notices 24 hours per day. The proposed posting location would be the window adjacent to the Auditor's Office entrance at the County Administration Building.

Supervisor George reported participating in the first regional Early Childhood Iowa meeting with Dubuque, Clinton, and Jackson Counties following the formation of the new district. She also attended the River Bend Transit annual meeting. Upcoming meetings included Early Childhood Iowa and the Regional Planning Affiliation Policy Technical Committee.

Supervisor Irwin reported on the upcoming participation in a Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization meeting, an Eastern Iowa Workforce Development Finance Committee meeting, and an Opioid Settlement Committee meeting to review a new funding proposal.

Supervisor Srp provided updates regarding several regional organizations and community activities. He discussed ongoing efforts involving Bridgeview and Bethany to transition certain behavioral health services to Community Health Care in response to reimbursement limitations affecting mental health providers. He encouraged residents to contact state legislators regarding Medicaid reimbursement rates for behavioral health services. Supervisor Srp also reported on the upcoming County Risk Management Committee meeting.

County Attorney Mike Wolf reported presenting a required attorney wellness program during the Iowa County Attorneys Association conference. He thanked the Board and the Sheriff's Office for their prompt efforts to warn residents about door-to-door solicitations for asphalt paving.

Treasurer Dustin Johnson reported that following completion of the annual tax sale, Clinton County had collected approximately 99.87 percent of all property taxes levied for the year. He noted that nuisance properties accounted for much of the remaining delinquent taxes and expressed appreciation for the continued cooperation between the Treasurer's Office and the City of Clinton in addressing abandoned properties.

Human Resources Director Ally Weller recognized employees reaching milestone service anniversaries, including Sergeant Brian Grell (25 years), Steve Tegeler (30 years), and Christine Hartman (1 year). She further reported that Clinton County had achieved an Experience Modification Rate (EMR) of 0.57, one of the lowest possible ratings, resulting in substantial workers' compensation savings and statewide recognition for the County's risk management

practices. The board was also informed that the Nurse Practitioner had recently resigned, creating an immediate vacancy within the County's Jail services. Due to the specialized nature of the position and the anticipated difficulty in recruiting qualified candidates, a request for informal concurrence from the Board is made to begin advertising the position before formal authorization to hire.

RESOLUTIONS

Resolution – Lease Agreement with the Clinton Substance Abuse Council: The Board considered a proposed lease agreement with the Clinton Substance Abuse Council for office space within the County Administration Building. During the discussion, representatives of the Council requested a reduction in leased square footage to better reflect their current operational needs, noting the organization no longer required as much storage space. County staff explained that questions had also arisen regarding the calculation of leased square footage, specifically whether common hallway and reception areas had been included in the original lease agreement. No Action Was Taken

Resolution – Assistant County Attorney Transition Planning: County Attorney Mike Wolf presented a resolution requesting authorization to begin recruiting an additional Assistant County Attorney as part of succession planning following his previously announced retirement. Wolf explained that the request was intended to begin a discussion of the significant shortage of attorneys available to serve rural Iowa counties and emphasized the importance of ensuring the continuity of operations within the County Attorney's Office. Wolf reported that Clinton County has been identified as an "Urgent Legal Desert," one of only a few Iowa counties experiencing a critical shortage of practicing attorneys. He cited statewide data demonstrating that attorney vacancies remain open for extended periods, an increasing percentage of Iowa attorneys are approaching retirement age, and law schools are not graduating enough attorneys to meet projected demand. He also noted that many new graduates pursue employment outside rural communities, further reducing the available applicant pool. Board members expressed support for proactively addressing the anticipated vacancy and acknowledged the challenges facing rural counties in recruiting attorneys. No Action Was Taken

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Posting Of Medical Examiner Vacancy: Representatives from the Emergency Management Agency appeared before the Board to discuss staffing needs related to Medical Examiner Transport positions. Discussion included the anticipated costs associated with filling the vacancies and confirmation that the currently approved staffing level for Medical Examiner Transporters is eight (8) positions.
