WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Supervisors (hereinafter “Board”) has determined certain Clinton County agricultural property should be leased to the highest bidder for a two-year period; March 1, 2027 to February 28, 2029. The real property is known as the "CLINTON COUNTY FARM" consisting of approximately 158.39 tillable acres (FSA Farm #1949) situated in Clinton County, Iowa; and legally described, as follows:

Parcel "A", being the South One-half of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 35, Township 83 North, Range 4 East of the 5th P.M.; and Parcels "B" and "B-1", being part of the North One-half of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 2, Township 82 North, Range 4, East of the 5th P.M., Clinton County, Iowa, these parcels identified on the Plat of Survey recorded as Instrument No. 2008-08825 in the Office of the Clinton County Recorder; and Parcel "C", being part of the North One-half of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 2, Township 82 North, Range 4, East of the 5th P.M., Clinton County, Iowa, this parcel identified on the Plat of Survey recorded as Instrument No. 2008-08824 in the Office of the Clinton County Recorder.

Excepting therefrom the 1.61-acre Parcel "B" as shown on the survey dated November 2, 2008, and recorded as Instrument No. 2008-08824 in the Office of the Clinton County Recorder.

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it would be best to lease the Clinton County Farm by asking for sealed bids for the annual rent for two crop years to obtain the highest possible price. Sealed bids will be accepted by the County Auditor up to a specified date and time. Sealed bids must be accompanied by a non-refundable down-payment of ten (10) percent to be applied to the first half rent (each crop year’s rent will be paid in two payments – March 1 and November 1 – or the entire amount in March if the renter prefers). The highest bid will be awarded the right to lease the Clinton County Farm for two years from March 1, 2027 to February 28, 2029 (for agricultural use in growing either corn or soybeans). All unsuccessful bidders' down payments will be returned. The Board reserves the right to waive at any time these specific bidding requirements and adopt alternative/additional requirement if they benefit the County) at the Board’s discretion after discussion and vote.

BE IT RESOLVED the Board reserves the right to award the lease to a responsible bidder submitting the highest acceptable cash rental bid, subject to the Board’s determination that the bid is in the best interests of Clinton County. The Board’s consideration of what is a responsible bidder includes the following: ability to perform the lease, farming experience, compliance with lease terms, prior performance on county property, financial ability to pay, conservation/stewardship requirements, etc. Acceptance or rejection of bids may be determined at the time the sealed bids are opened, but no later than ten (10) days after the opening of the bids. If the highest bid is accepted, the successful bidder must sign the lease on the property no later than one (1) month after the bid is accepted (failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the down payment to Clinton County). Attorney Robert McGee will handle the lease agreement of the Clinton County Farm on behalf of Clinton County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board will open the closed bids received by the County Auditor on September 18, 2026, at 10 a.m. in the Board of Supervisor's Conference Room "C", Clinton County Administration Building, 1900 N. 3rd St., Clinton, Iowa. The Board will also decide and take action on the Lease acceptance on September 28, 2026, at 10 a.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board reserves the right to waive any deficiencies in the procedures outlined for the lease of the Clinton County Farm.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Clinton County Auditor shall publish notice of this Resolution twice; once immediately after this Resolution is approved, and again ten to fourteen days later.
