DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor David Troester: Reported continued preparations for the September 8 Special Election and November General Election, with Special Election ballots completed and General Election ballot preparation underway.

Supervisor Erin George: Reported on various meetings and noted upcoming Eastern Iowa Early Childhood and RPA meetings.

Supervisor Jim Irwin: Reported on various meetings and discussed information presented at the ISAC Conference.

Board Chair Dan Srp: Reported on various meetings and highlighted the final Music on the Avenue event and new public artwork installed in downtown Clinton.

Conservation Director Phil Visser: Reported on the Rock Creek Catfish Classic. He also advised that low Mississippi River levels were creating boating concerns and required the suspension of Blue Heron cruises.

DISCUSSIONS WITH POSSIBLE ACTIONS

EMA Hazard Mitigation Planning Update - County Supervisor Participant Emergency Management: Provided an update on the required five-year revision of the County Hazard Mitigation Plan, noting that maintaining a current plan is necessary for eligibility for certain federal grant funding. Supervisor George volunteered to represent the Board during the planning process, which will include committee and public meetings.

Payroll Updates: An audit of employee benefit deductions identified system errors affecting insurance rates, and other discrepancies are being reviewed and corrected. Human Resources and the Auditor's Office also discussed additional auditing procedures and the need for improved tracking and communication when payroll corrections are identified. FY2026 year-end payroll accrual information and documentation of payroll corrections are due by August 31st, 2026. The Board discussed employee concerns about payroll errors, ongoing efforts to identify and correct them, and the importance of communicating with affected employees and departments.

9:45 A.M. EXEMPT MEETING – SHERIFF UNION CONTRACT NEGOTIATION PLANNING

The Board met in an exempt session for the purpose of discussing strategy and planning related to collective bargaining negotiations with the Sheriff’s Union.

This meeting is exempt from the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 21 under Iowa Code § 20.17(3), which exempts negotiating sessions and strategy meetings of public employers regarding collective bargaining matters from the Iowa Open Meetings Law.
